Brahmagupta was the most

famous mathematician after Varahamihira. As recorded by himself, he was the son of Jisnugupta and has published his ^{ग्रन्थानुसूल} Brahmaguptasiddhanta at ^{४५०} when he was only 30 years old. The Brahmaguptasiddhanta, though mainly an astronomical work, still has four and half chapters devoted to mathematics including arithmetic and Alzebra. His 12th chapter deals with arithmetic and 18th with alzebra.

Through Brahmagupta's work the Arabs learnt Indian astronomy nearly one and half centuries later. This work was

translated by the Arab astronomer Muhammad Bin Musa.
