

Aryabhata : Aryabhata<sup>(5th century)</sup> was

the famous astrologer-nerve of  
Kusumapura. He was the first  
to assert that the earth is a  
sphere and that it rotates  
round the Sun. His works include  
Aryabhataiya (आर्षभटीया), दृशागितिकारम्भ  
with numerical notations, and  
आर्षभस्तोत्र, collection of 108 verses  
in Arya metre. Aryastakata comp-  
rises three sections - mathematics  
(गणित), measurement of time  
(कालक्रिया), astronomy (Gola).

The गणितपाद consists of 33 Arya-  
stanzas; the कालक्रियापाद in 25  
verses, contains the basic principles  
of astrological time calculation and  
the Gola<sup>(गोलपाद)</sup> in 50 stanzas deals  
with the celestial sphere.

In the 10<sup>th</sup> century A.D. came  
another Aryabhata who was known  
to Alberuni. This Aryabhata, in  
his Aryasiddhanta uses numerical  
notations of a different kind.
